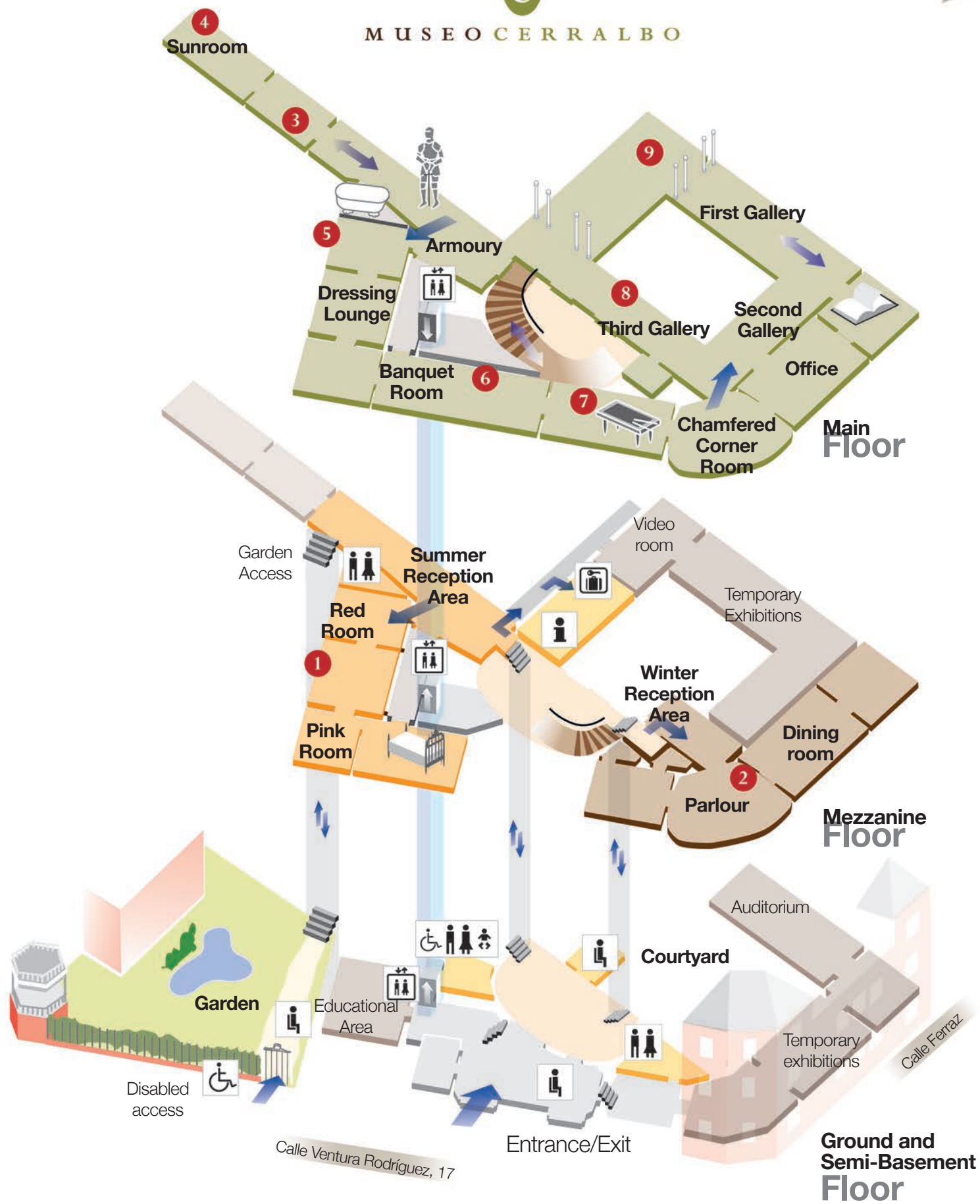

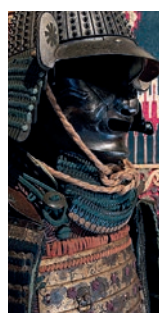

1 The original **wallpaper** preserved in the Yellow Room.

4 **Iberian falcata** from the necropolis of Las Angosturas in Granada, with striking silver decoration.

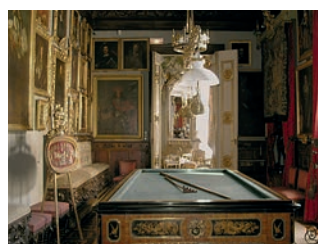


5 The **Room of Little Columns**, profusely decorated with 18th century ceramic busts, votive offerings and idols from Antiquity.

Maximum capacity limited to 60 people simultaneously for conservation reasons.
